Opening Comments - Bruce, N1LN

Upcoming Meeting Agendas –

- o The Board members have been busy scheduling programs for upcoming months.
- The focus of tonight's meeting is Field Day which is very important and will be coming up in just over two months.
- At May 9th Membership Meeting, Virginia Enzor (NC4VA) will give a SkyWarn presentation. This will be a combined meeting with participants on Zoom and also on UHF. Prior to the meeting, a URL and/or slides will be sent to the reflector to ensure everyone can follow along with the presentation. It has been a few years since our group has had SkyWarn training. This will be timely since we will be in hurricane season at the time of the presentation.
- Our June 13th Membership Meeting will take place about a week and a half before Field Day. The focus of our June meeting will be final preparation for Field Day. We'll ensure there are no gaps in planning and that all bases are covered for folks who will be participating at home and on-site.
- The Tri-County (Durham, Orange, Chatham) repeater analysis and plan will be the main presentation at our July 11th Membership Meeting. Dan (KR4UB) will give us an overview of the history of the repeaters, how the analysis was developed, our current status in terms of being able to get into the repeaters, and where we are going in terms of being able to fund, maintain and hopefully improve communication capabilities.

ARRL 2022 Field Day update – Dave (W4SAR) and Bruce (N1LN)

- Bruce thanked everyone who responded to the Field Day survey that was recently sent to the reflector. The information that was received was very helpful in forming the OCRA/DFMA Field Day plans for this year.
- There was a total of 52 responses.
 - o 9 folks plan to work from home (some will help with site setup / takedown)
 - o 28 folks plan to participate at the OCRA/DFMA site
 - 15 folks will not be able to participate

 - Wilson (W4BOH) -
 - Wilson echoed remarks already made about there being enough work for everyone. The work will start on Thursday afternoon. If you can, please raise your hand to help! For those who haven't participated in Field Day before, this is a great opportunity not only to help but to learn with handson experience.
 - There is no charge for the potluck dinner that will be held on Friday evening. The main course is Wilson's gift to the club. [Thank you, Wilson!]
 - The on-site Field Day event will take place on Wilson's property. There are site rules that will be dusted off and circulated. There will be no alcohol consumption until dinner time.
 - Wilson will be devoted to CW.
 - UNASSIGNED Action Item: That means the 20M SSB station is still in need of an installation location and a band captain.
 - o Bill (KI4RAN) -
 - Bill reminded everyone that there should not be any running on the Field Day site regardless of time of day or night. Running could be a personal injury hazard.
 - John (KM4MDR) -
 - John has volunteered to coordinate the organization of food and drinks for Friday afternoon lunch and Friday night potluck dinner.
 - Action Item: John will send an email to the reflector to begin organizing the Friday night potluck. Wilson will cook and provide pork barbeque. If you prefer a different main dish, you're welcome to bring your own food to cook on the grill. The rest of the dinner is provided by those who attend and bring casseroles, salads, desserts, and other dishes. Many people bring their specialty dishes.
 - Action Item: There was an indication that there are quite a few paper goods and other supply items
 that the club has from previous potluck dinners. This needs to be verified.

 - Action Item: Bruce (N1LN) will send an email to the reflector that lists the band captains and other key Field Day people for those who will need to contact them.
 - UNASSIGNED Action Item: The OCRA/DFMA Board Members will discuss options for Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast. The decision will determine the level of support needed from club membership.
